Message from the Chair and CEO

CSD plays a critical role as the sole supplier of cotton seed in the Australian cotton industry. This responsibility drives our commitment to delivering high-quality seed, in full and on time, by maintaining a reliable supply chain. We relish this as an opportunity to contribute positive change for the Australian cotton industry and communities.

We are a leading seed and technology company, enabling Australian growers to produce the most desirable, profitable, and sustainable cotton.

Our plan's objectives are ambitious. For the growers of Australian cotton, we aim to:

- Develop varieties that maintain our growers competitiveness and profitability, exceeding leading global standards;
- Grow the area of cotton production to 850,000 hectares, through supporting development in northern Australia and increasing our dryland production areas; and
- Target key disease issues, specifically verticillium wilt, fusarium wilt, black root rot and emerging tropical diseases.

Reflecting on our previous Strategic Plan (2020-2025), we are proud of the progress we have made. Despite significant challenges in its early stages, like the 2020 floods and the COVID-19 pandemic, we worked within restrictions to continue to produce and deliver high quality seed to our growers. CSD and CSIRO extended the Cotton Breeding Australia Joint Venture to 2034, providing research and capital commitment for our industry into the future. We also embraced growers feedback on varietals, seed quality and timeliness and in response launched the Seed Quality Improvement Plan in 2024.

To develop CSD's 2025-2030 Strategic Plan, we conducted over 50 stakeholder consultations to better understand the key challenges shaping the future of

the Australian cotton industry and how CSD can play a role in addressing these challenges. We engaged with growers, agronomists, agents, industry and research partners from across all cotton-growing regions - from the Northern Territory to the Riverina - as well as globally. We also listened carefully to all the issues raised relating to CSD's operations from our Seed Increase Program, through to seed quality and customer service.

Our plan is structured around three strategic pillars.

- 1. Exceptional Customer Experiences, where we seek to maximise value for our customers by helping them to grow a more profitable and sustainable business.
- Creating Future Solutions, through which we strive to address key industry challenges and maintain the competitiveness of Australian cotton.
- 3. People at the Centre, which harnesses the collective capabilities of our people, members and industry.

This plan covers the next five years, but the nature of our business means we need to look beyond that horizon. Accordingly, the plan establishes the foundations for the Australian cotton industry's success beyond 2030. We are also pleased to share the establishment of a collaborative industry fund, outlining CSD's strategic role in supporting the future of the Australian cotton industry through collaboration and investment in industry-good initiatives.

In closing, we look forward to working together to bring this vision to life. Together, we will continue to drive the growth, profitability, and sustainability of the Australian cotton industry for generations to come.



Future Cotton

True to our founding charter, we continue to refine how we invest our earnings for the benefit of the Australian cotton industry.

- As a member-based organisation since 1967, CSD exists to support the long-term success of the Australian cotton industry.
- In recent years CSD has delivered great results enabling it to build a strong financial position.
- CSD's members and stakeholders expect CSD to have a clear strategy for applying future surpluses to strengthen CSD's research and operations capabilities and support industry programs and communities.

Reserves standard

- Recognising its critical role in the Australian cotton industry, CSD established a Reserve Standard (2013) to support business continuity.
- This ensures resilience in adverse environmental conditions, supports multi-year commitments to germplasm and traits research and provides self-insurance.
- CSD will adopt annual operating budgets that are aligned to the delivery of the strategic plan and such that future surpluses are deployed in an effective and financially sustainable manner.

Updates to future approach

In addition to ensuring the maintenance of our reserve standard, we will continue to develop the framework for the investment of any surpluses to the benefit of the industry, in accordance with our charter. The key areas of investment are:

- a. Improving cotton seed resilience, yield, quality and sustainability through our RD&E program
- Upgrading CSD's operating infrastructure e.g. automation
- c. Fostering community engagement through sponsorship and development programs
- d. Partner with key stakeholders, including Australian Cotton Shippers Association, Cotton Research and Development Corporation and Cotton Australia to identify and support high-priority initiatives for the Australian cotton industry.


